

STOW-MUNROE FALLS BAND BOOSTERS ASSOCIATION STUDENT ACCOUNTS

As part of the Band Booster's charter to support the band program the band boosters association has created a STUDENT ACCOUNT line item in their Budget.

Throughout the year, students are given the opportunity to participate in fundraisers to help them defray the costs of the following activities:

- * Band Camp
- * Band Trips
- * Purchase of Uniform Parts or Uniform Fees (in August only)
- * High School Band Banquet.

All profits of student fundraisers are held in a band booster's account and are marked with the student's name. All balances are posted quarterly on the band web page in the Student Account section. Students are identified by their school ID numbers. Students may then apply all or a portion of the total to one of the areas listed above.

If a student drops from the band program, we will transfer the balance to a sibling's account. If there is not a sibling currently in the program, all funds will be placed in the Band Booster's General Fund. No individual checks will be written.

At the end of the senior year, students will have the option to tell us how they want the remainder of their account spent. If the student has a sibling, any remaining funds are automatically transferred to the sibling's account. If this is not possible, the student may choose one of the following options.

- 1) Donate the money left in the account to a friend.
- 2) Donate the money to the uniform fund.

If the student does not make a selection by June 15, the remaining funds are automatically transferred to the Band Boosters General Fund.
