

AUDITION INSTRUCTIONS:

All Freshmen will continue on the Marching Band Schedule next week.

- * **The MUSIC AREA is CLOSED next week during band periods.** There will be no passes given for periods 5-9 unless you have a scheduled audition during that time. Freshmen will report to the Auditorium during 5/6 unless auditioning. Students in the Auditorium will be seated and quiet. You should have something to do. **NO PASSES WILL BE GIVEN FOR LOCKERS or RESTROOMS.**

- * **If you need a pass to warm up (early auditions) please get one the day before your auditions.**

- * **The BAND ROOM is for warming up and a study hall when finished.** If you are auditioning during your lunch period, you may eat in the band room before or after your audition. **No one may leave the music area during periods until the bell.** No passes will be given to get things or lunches.

- * **The only people who are in the band hallway should be students who are next to audition.** This is to keep the halls quiet for everyone.

- * **Auditions are only 8 minutes long and include Scales & Sight-reading.** Be prepared for your audition. You will be given one chance to play your scales. No restarts. For sight-reading you will be given 1 minute to study then you play the selection.

- * **PLEASE WAIT IN THE BAND ROOM UNTIL THE BELL RINGS AT THE END OF PERIOD 5/6 or 7/8. AUDITIONS CONTINUE PERIOD 9 and 10 AND WE WANT TO KEEP THE AREA QUIET.**

- * **RESULTS WILL BE POSTED BY 6:00PM on FRIDAY, NOV. 8**

- * **WHILE WE ARE IN PLAYOFFS, All Fridays will be "FOOTBALL FRIDAYS"** we will meet as a MARCHING BAND during periods 7/8. You will need to bring Shoes, Marching Band Instruments and flip folios that day.

- * **WE WILL MEET AS BANDS ON MONDAY, NOV. 11th.** Freshman will start your band during period 5/6 and will report to studyhall 7/8.

- * **TUBAS:** If you have a tuba at home, you must bring it in on the day of your audition. This is the TUBA you will be playing for your audition.
